Kaz Murphy goes waaaay back. And now, with an innovative new album, the singer-songwriter is back in the saddle. with "Ride Out the Storm" this September. The live sessions were recorded in April at The Zone in Dripping Springs, TX with producer Scrappy Jud Newcomb, who had this to say: "When I read the titles I was intrigued, then when I heard the music and studied the lyrics, I thought, the world needs to hear more Kaz Murphy." Engineered and mastered by Pat Manske.

In 1997 No Depression wrote that Murphy's first solo CD, "One Happy Camper," was "packed with songs so full of rich imagery, quirky characters, cultural insights and instrumental diversity that if there were such a thing as classic Americana, this would be it." His third CD, "Home For Mistfits" (2007) won Album of the Year at Rockwired and on Mike Lidskin's Twirl Radio. As a long-coming follow up to "Misfits" time and experience has honed Murphy's signature voice and abilities. With Newcomb on various guitars, mandolin, bass and vocals, Manske on drums, and Notarthomas on bass, tremolo, baritone guitars and vocals, the live cuts are executed with assured badass backbone. The mix of mandolin and baritone guitar creates a refreshingly haunting Americana backdrop of bluegrass undertones, with Tex Mex accents provided by Newcomb, and Notarthomas alluding to one of Kaz's musical mentors, Morricone. Penny Jo Pullus contributed her sweet backups on two songs. Manske's masterful drum tracks evoke Nashville and Texas' finest artists.

#1 "When People Come Together" is a folksy call to arms, an anthem to the power of the people: "Gonna ride out the storm. gonna rescue

the forlorn, from a harder day.”#8 Somebody Could Be Me” salutes the sensibility of John Sebastian, with a lilting country/western groove, and the bittersweet vocal style reminiscent of Glen Campbell: “Well I hear she’s out, out for somebody, well that somebody could be me.”

Murphy leads the listener on a rustic stroll along rutted, weathered roads through locked back doors, and into fragile slices of American life, “Storm” reveals stripped down instrumentation, as a contrast to previous efforts known for their “roots orchestra” production. The collection rings true to Kaz’s folk roots, and he opens emotional doors formerly locked in the corners of his heart and soul, to write about hopeful doers that inevitably come to ride out their own storm.

Bill Wence Promotions is spearheading the album campaign to Americana radio and the single “Somebody Could Be Me” to Country radio and so far the music has been met with warm reception.

A video with Producer Dale Roy Robinson is scheduled for the Fall.
